Community Health Northwest Florida Welcomes New Pediatrician To Staff

Pensacola, FL - Community Health Northwest Florida, formerly Escambia Community Clinics, welcomes local pediatrician Samuel Ravenel, MD, FAAP, to its provider staff beginning July 1, 2018. Dr. Ravenel's pediatric practice is located within Community Health Northwest Florida's Cantonment Pediatrics at 470 South Highway 29 in Cantonment, FL. Cantonment Pediatrics provides medical, dental and behavioral health care in one convenient location for families in Cantonment and surrounding communities.

Dr. Ravenel, a General Pediatrician, is board certified with the American Board of Pediatrics and a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics. A 1997 graduate of The Medical University of South Carolina, Dr. Ravenel completed his pediatric residency at Eastern Virginia Medical School in Norfolk, VA.

Dr. Ravenel is now accepting new patients from 0 through 18 years of age. A wide range of pediatric services are available, including well-baby and well-child checkups, immunizations, routine physicals, diagnosis and treatment of illnesses, and management of chronic conditions such as allergies, asthma, and ADHD.

Since 1992, Community Health Northwest Florida has served residents of Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties and surrounding areas. Since 2007, it has been the area's only Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC). A Florida Medicaid, Humana and Molina managed care provider, the organization also accepts Alabama Medicaid at some locations and as well as many private health insurances. A sliding fee scale program for those individuals who do not have insurance coverage is also offered to eligible patients.
