**COMMUNITY HEALTH NORTHWEST FLORIDA RESUMES USE OF
JOHNSON & JOHNSON (JANSSEN) VACCINE AND WELCOMES WALK-INS AT UPCOMING CLINICS**

PENSACOLA, FL – This week Community Health Northwest Florida will resume use of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine, per CDC recommendation, and has announced two new vaccination clinics to take place at the Brownsville Community Center in Pensacola on April 30th and May 1st.

At the Friday April 30th event, all participants will receive the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, while on **Saturday May 1st** participants will have the opportunity to choose between the Johnson & Johnson (“One and Done”) vaccine and the dose #1 of the Moderna vaccine. Eligible persons who wish to participate in one of these events may call the Community Health COVID-19 Vaccine Call Center at **850-439-3358** to schedule an appointment, or may arrive at their convenience for a Walk-in appointment. *Choice of COVID-19 Vaccine: **Johnson & Johnson** (One and Done) *or* **Moderna** 1st Dose*

To Participate: Appointment (Call 850.439.3358) *OR* Walk-in from 8AM-11AM

These clinics are open to all Florida residents who qualify to receive the vaccine, including those covered under the Governor’s latest Executive Orders. Currently, the amended order expands the groups eligible to receive the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine in Florida to include **all people age 18 and older**.

IMPORTANT:

- All participants will be required to show photo ID at time of appointment.
- Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days *or* have had symptoms of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) in the past 14 days should not receive the vaccine.
