**IMPORTANT:**

- Community Health Northwest Florida encourages all Florida residents age 12 and older who have not yet received the COVID-19 vaccine to take advantage of one of these vaccination opportunities.
- All adult participants will be required to show photo ID at time of appointment.
- Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days *or* have had symptoms of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) in the past 14 days should not receive the vaccine.
