COMMUNITY HEALTH NORTHWEST FLORIDA ANNOUNCES VACCINE CLINICS FOR WEEK ENDING AUGUST 21

PENSACOLA, FL – Next week Community Health Northwest Florida, in partnership with Escambia County, will continue to operate its walk-in vaccination clinic inside Brownsville Community Center. The clinic is open to individuals age 18 and older every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9am to 1pm. Participants have the choice of the Moderna (2 dose) or Johnson & Johnson (one and done) vaccine.

In addition to the Brownsville clinic, Community Health Northwest Florida continues to offer several on-site vaccination opportunities at select CHNWF locations and special events:

Wednesday, August 18 from 3PM – 5PM

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Friday, August 20 from 3PM – 5PM

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Friday August 20 from 5PM – 7:30PM

Location: Downtown Pensacola, specific address TBA

Vaccine: Moderna (ages 18+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Incentive: First 100 scheduled appointments receive a \$25 Walmart gift card

Saturday August 21 from 9AM – 3:30PM

Location: “Super Sprout” Wellness Event @ CHNWF Pediatric Convenient Care – 5375 N. 9th Ave., Pensacola

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Community Health Northwest Florida encourages all individuals age 12 and older who have not yet received the COVID-19 vaccine to take advantage of one of these vaccination opportunities. Persons wishing to participate in any CHNWF vaccination clinic may call the **Community Health Vaccine Call Center at 850-439-3358** to schedule an appointment or simply **walk in** at their convenience during regular operating hours.

IMPORTANT:

- All adult participants will be required to show photo ID at time of appointment.
- Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days *or* have had symptoms of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) in the past 14 days ***should not receive the vaccine and should not enter clinic facility.***
