COMMUNITY HEALTH NORTHWEST FLORIDA OFFERS COVID VACCINATION OPPORTUNITIES

PENSACOLA, FL – This week Community Health Northwest Florida, in partnership with Escambia County, will continue to operate its walk-in vaccination clinic inside Brownsville Community Center. The clinic is open to individuals age 18 and older. Participants have the choice of the Moderna (two-dose) or Johnson & Johnson (one and done) vaccine.

Wednesday, Sept. 8 and Friday, Sept. 10 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Location: Brownsville Community Center – 3200 W. Desoto St., Pensacola, FL

Vaccine: Moderna (ages 18+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

In addition to the Brownsville clinic, Community Health Northwest Florida continues to offer several vaccination opportunities at select Community Health locations, featuring convenient after-school and weekend hours.

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Saturday, Sept. 11 from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Location: CHNWF Trinity Pediatrics – 5375 N. 9th Ave., Pensacola

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Sunday, Sept. 12 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Location: Marie K. Young Wedgewood Community Center - 6405 Wagner Rd., Pensacola

Vaccine: Pfizer (ages 12+) and Johnson & Johnson (ages 18+)

Community Health Northwest Florida encourages all individuals age 12 and older who have not yet received the COVID-19 vaccine to take advantage of one of these vaccination opportunities. Persons wishing to participate in any CHNWF vaccination clinic may call the **Community Health Vaccine Call Center at 850-439-3358** to schedule an appointment or simply **walk in** at their convenience during regular operating hours.

IMPORTANT:

- All adult participants will be required to show photo ID at time of appointment.
- Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days *or* have had symptoms of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) in the past 14 days ***should not receive the vaccine and should not enter clinic facility.***
